Parent / Student Soccer Games

Free Flu Shots

The Manitowoc County Health Department has scheduled a walk in Flu Clinic for children 6 months through 18 years of age. The clinic will be held at the Health Dept. located at 1028 S 9th St in Manitowoc. **The influenza vaccine will be free; no insurance restrictions apply as these clinics are part of the Health Department's preparedness plan.**

The clinic will be held on Monday October 24th from 3PM to 5:30PM. No appointment is necessary. Only the injectable vaccine will be offered. Parents/guardians need to accompany children to the clinic. The CDC recommends that everyone six months of age and older get an influenza vaccine each year.
